SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association annually offers scholarships to students majoring or planning to major in agriculture, veterinary medicine or other fields of study. The purpose of the scholarships is to encourage personal growth and knowledge.

An applicants must be a at least a high school senior at time of application and a resident of one of the following Florida counties: Duval, Baker, Bradford, Clay, Nassau or St. Johns County. The applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll in a technical institution, junior college, or four year university.

The Scholarship Committee of the Greater Jacksonville Fair will review all complete applications. Winners will be announced during the Greater Jacksonville Fair. Decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

Scholarship funds will be assigned to and administered by the applicant's college, university or technical institution. Should a scholarship winner drop out of school, any unused portion of scholarship funds will be returned to the Fair.
